The Class fee is \$500.00 per person, the fee is **not** required at time of registration. Dust Monitor classes are scheduled as needed, requiring a minimum of 10 paid registrants to conduct a class. Once sufficient registrations have been received, a class will be scheduled and you will be informed of the date, time, location, and payment deadline. Time periods between classes can vary widely, with the average being approximately one class every two months.

Companies can request a class be scheduled by guaranteeing the minimum \$5000.00 fee. For more information contact the Air Quality, Dust Monitor class coordinator.

The class fee includes the two day Dust Monitor class plus the required one day US EPA Method 9 Visible Emissions Evaluation (VEE) class, more commonly known as Smoke School. After successful completion of the Dust Monitor class, attendees may exercise the duties of a Dust Monitor prior to completion of the VEE class. The included VEE class is conducted semi-annually by a vender contracted by Air Quality. Persons that have completed the Dust Monitor class must successfully complete this VEE course or another approved course within six months; once complete their Dust Monitor certification is valid for its full 3 year period.
