1. **UC-0766-13 – THOMPSON FAMILY TRUST:**
USE PERMITS for the following: **1)** allow an accessory structure not architecturally compatible with the principal structure; and **2)** allow an accessory structure to exceed one-half the footprint of the principal structure in conjunction with an existing single family residence on 1.0 acre in an R-E (Rural Estates Residential) (RNP-I) Zone. Generally located on the east side of Montessouri Street, 200 feet south of Eldora Avenue within Spring Valley. SB/gc/ml (For possible action)
2. **VS-0756-13 – LV POST, LLC:**
VACATE AND ABANDON a portion of right-of-way being Durango Drive located between Post Road and Teco Avenue (alignment) within Spring Valley (description on file). SB/jt/ml (For possible action)

6. **UC-0138-11 (ET-0115-13) – MADRAS DURANGO, LLC:**
USE PERMITS FIRST EXTENSION OF TIME to commence the following: **1)** a convenience store; **2)** reduce the separation from a convenience store to a residential use; **3)** a service station; and **4)** reduce the setback from a service station to a residential use.
DESIGN REVIEW for a commercial development consisting of an office and retail building, convenience store, and service station on 1.4 acres in a C-1 (Local Business) Zone in the CMA Design Overlay District.
