10/09/14 18:13 served vicious declaration to Ms. Kaye. Explained the process and she completed the appeal. Advised of AAC hearing date of 10/30/14 at 1830 at CCGC. Ms. Kaye may seek legal options. Ms. Kaye inquired about requirements in case vicious is overturned. I toured the home and yard and pointed out several deficiencies, specifically the height of the block wall on the west side of the yard due to the retaining wall next to the main wall. This would allow the dog to jump. There is also a short wall on the east side and there were 2 ottomans next to the wall that would permit the dog to jump over. Additionally, a motor vehicle is in the backyard on the east side and the dog could possibly use that to jump over the wall or gate. The crawl space under the split level house has no access door, which would permit the dog to access the underside of the house and possibly other escape routes. Ms. Kaye advised that a door was going to be put on that. Advised Ms. Kaye to contact us with further questions, although we could not give legal advice. cc102

I was Dispatched to respond reference Metro Event# 14-09-28-2099 Upon arrival on scene 4 Metro units had a brown adult Female Pity-type dog cornered in the front yard of 4121 Reno the animal was bloodied from the Mouth and had an open bleeding wound to the top of its head, it looked like a small caliber gunshot, I approached the dog it growled Barked and showed teeth, I did not retreat and the animal Turned I spoke with the dog and it calmed itself I invited the dog to be petted and Drooped the catch-pole as to ease the animals tension, I turned my back to the Dog and squatted down and patted the ground calling the dog it came close sniffed and then circled around wanting pets, I leashed the dog and took the animal and loaded her onto the county vehicle at this time I could see the wound more closely and noticed it was 2 tears to the top of the head, I began speaking with Metro and gathering intel and handed out and spoke with Witnesses, the owner arrived back on scene he was bloodied and I questioned if he had been Bitten he stated no, it was from his pet, that the owner advised was at 3340 e. Patrick emergency animal hospital, he was given a witness statements for his Wife and her sister as they were the ones walking the dog when the attack occurred, he was also given a Vets Prognosis and diagnosis form for the treating Vet to fill out and send to CCAC. I then spoke with a couple{{ Mr. and Mrs.Crivello}} that had witnessed the attack and they were given witness statements the wife filled out hers on Scene others will follow spoke with{{{ Mr. Dave Coon}}} he had assisted in trying to Stop the attack that he witnessed, with a hammer that was in his Vehicle, {{{Wounds to Pity}}} He was also left a witness statement Metro Officer P. Zygmunt # 8558 from Metro stayed on scene till home was Posted and witnesses were Questioned , posted the possible residence reference the Attacking dogs front door of the Residence in question.I photo documented the residence that the animal# 750869 was Impounded from the Open front yard and the front door was posted, CC#107

09292014 1755 Hrs., Met with Owner D'layne Kave #557457 at Lied Animal Care Center, she was there to reclaim her Pet, she was asked and Provided an NV DI for [redacted] she was Advised that the animal her dog # 750869 Karona had attacked and ultimately killed the Leashed animal that was Being walked by its Owners when it ran Off Property and Viciously and Brutally without cause or reason grabbed and shook the animal until it succumbed to its aggressor and Passed out from the horrendous assault, Upon the carefree Snauzer-type Pet dog, that was being walking and under the control of its responsible Owner.

She stated as she began to Cry that she was unaware her dog had in fact killed the Innocent snauzer and appeared Upset, I explained the Process and asked if she wanted the Option to sign Her Dangerous animal over for Immediate Humane Euthanasia, she stated she had to call her Mother First.

I issued the Dangerous Declaration to the owner and she signed and Received a Copy, I gave her back her Id and gave her a few Moments to consider the appropriate Option she was being given, after this time the Owner advised CCAC Officer CC#107 Myself, that she wanted to see the animal and she did not want to have the option for Euthanasia of her aggressive pet.

I gave her a witness statement and asked if she chose to, to fill it out an send it in, she was advised also that CCAC was aware of 2 previous incidents in Henderson jurisdiction were her animal had ran loose attacking other pets and that fact would be presented at the Hearing. I advised that I was also looking into the aspect of possible attempting to see if her animal fit the Criteria for a vicious animal Declaration.



An animal may be declared dangerous by an animal control officer if it constitutes a physical threat to a human being or another animal, and there is an additional factor of either: within the prior eighteen months it was a threat to a person; or it was used in the commission of a crime, caused serious injury or death to an animal, or it exhibits a condition or behavior that is a threat to public safety.

Explanation of threat and factor: on 09-28-2014 at or about 16:10 Hrs. Animal #750869 did run loose and attack another animal that was leashed and with its Owners, while at large off property causing severe injury to animal, owner sought medical treatment. Owner took dog to Vet for treatment and a CCAC left a Vets Prognosis and Diagnosis form reference injury to the dog that was leashed and attacked.

Dangerous Animals Permits and Conditions: CCC 10.16.030 Any animal which is declared to be dangerous by the animal control officer may be kept within unincorporated Clark County, provided that: (a) Within fourteen days after the owner or keeper is notified of the declaration the area in which the owner or keeper intends to keep the animal must pass an inspection by the animal control officer and the owner or keeper must obtain from the animal control officer a permit to keep the animal based upon such terms and conditions as the animal control officer deems appropriate. A nonrefundable inspection fee of one hundred will be charged the owner or keeper. For purposes of this subsection, notice of the declaration shall be deemed complete if it is served personally, or upon mailing by certified mail, return receipt requested, sent to the last known address of the owner or keeper. (b) The animal shall be kept, confined or housed within an enclosure deemed adequate by the animal control officer: (1) That will ensure the animal's retention and comfort, is of a size to permit the animal to stand upright, and is of a dimension deemed adequate by the animal control officer; and (2) That is secure enough so that the animal cannot bite, harm or injure anyone overreaching the top of the fence or other enclosure. (c) At no time shall the animal be allowed to leave the private property confines of the owner or person in charge of the animal unless it is muzzled, leashed and under the effective control of an adult. (d) The private property shall be adequately and properly posted with conspicuous warning signs, with a listing of the name and telephone number of the owner of the animal. (e) The animal must be sterilized by a licensed veterinarian. The owner or keeper shall maintain all sterilization records, including the type of animal sterilized, the name of the veterinarian performing the procedure, and the date the sterilization was performed. (f) The animal shall be implanted with an electronic microchip from a manufacturer approved by the animal control officer. The implantation must be performed by a licensed veterinarian and must conform to procedures recommended by the manufacturer. The owner or keeper shall register the microchip number in a national database in accordance with instructions from the manufacturer, and shall provide the number to the animal control officer. (g) The owner or keeper shall obtain and maintain in effect a policy of liability insurance in the amount of not less than one hundred thousand dollars insuring against possible injuries inflicted by the dangerous animal. The liability insurance shall be maintained in effects long as the owner or keeper maintains possession of the dangerous animal. (h) The owner of a dangerous animal may not sell, relocate or give away the animal without first obtaining prior written approval from an animal control officer. If such a transaction is approved, the owner or transferee shall pay a nonrefundable inspection fee of one hundred dollars for inspection of the new location for the animal. The owner or transferee shall also have the national microchip number updated in the national database to reflect the change in ownership and shall provide evidence of the update to the animal control officer. CCC 10.16.040 (a) Any permit issued under Section 10.16.030 shall be revoked if the animal without provocation bites or attempts to bite any person or animal lawfully upon the permit property or upon any other property. (b) Any person who keeps a dangerous animal after his permit has been revoked or any person who keeps, houses, quarters, or in any way has under his care or custody a dangerous animal without first obtaining a permit as set forth in Section 10.16.030 is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Appeal Rights: The owner or keeper of any animal declared dangerous by the animal control officer may, within seven days after notice has been served personally or deposited in the mail, request a hearing to appeal the dangerous determination or failure to pass inspection, by proving a written request for a hearing to Clark County Animal Control, 2911 East Sunset Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89120. Conditions not otherwise required will be tolled pending a determination on such hearing.

The second attack took place on my usual morning walks with Nana before I head to school. Since the day of the first incident, Nana was too traumatized to even walk in front of that corner house, therefore, I changed our route so that we would enter our street on the opposite side, across the house. Usually during the time of my morning walk (6:30-7:00), the corner house's door is closed, and if on rare occasions the door is open, there is a gate to prevent the dog to exiting the home. Although today, the door was wide open with no gate at the door. When Nana and I were directly in front of the house, the dog ran from the inside, across the street, and towards Nana. Again, the dog came so fast and out of thin air it seemed like. Since I had a bit longer to react I immediately tried to pick up Nana to protect her. As I bent down, the dog finally approached and started biting at Nana. Since I was crouched when the dog came, I lost my balance and fell over next to the dog. My phone fell out of my pocket and cracked, but the dog payed no attention to me and just solely on Nana. When the owner came out and pryed his dog away, he again, kept apologizing. Though to be frank, I was substantially irritated and mad since this was the second time this happened and their door was wide open. Unlike the previous attacks Nana was actually bleeding due to the bite mark on her side.



Recommended Treatment

The following is the suggested treatment for your pet's condition. By following through on the recommended treatment, we can assist you in giving your pet a long and healthy life.

Drain Care

Your pet has a drain or drains that will require at-home care. Keep the region clean and dry between treatments. Pay special attention to keeping the regions free of urine and feces. Ensure that the wound (drain exit site) does not scab over to allow for discharge. Apply a warm, moist compress for 10-15 minutes or perform hydrotherapy for 5-10 minutes to the drain site every 8 hours for 7-10 days. The drain should be able to move about 1/4-1/2 inch from side-to-side after the treatments are completed.

The drain needs to be rechecked in 3-5 days for removal. Any suture or staples should be removed in 14 days. Should the wound(s) worsen contact your veterinarian or follow-up with Animal Emergency Center immediately.

This is to inform you that on September 28, 2014 at approximately 4:10 pm, a brown and white intact female pit bull, 1 year of age named "Karon" belonging to you, was running at large near 4136 Reno Avenue, located within the unincorporated area of Clark County, when she aggressively attacked another animal.

Your dog was not properly restrained by means of adequate control allowing her to attack and bite a schnauzer dog causing or death. Your dog was also involved in 2 other biting incidents in the City of Henderson in the past year.

Because your dog was not lawfully restrained, and because of the death it caused, coupled with the prior incidents, the Animal Control Officer has declared the above-described dog **vicious**, as authorized under the provisions of Clark County Code 10.16.010. Ownership of a vicious animal in Clark County and the State of Nevada is unlawful.

In accordance with Clark County Code 10.16.050, you have 7 days after this notice is personally served or deposited in the mail to do one of the following:

1. Voluntarily relinquish ownership of the animal for euthanasia.
2. Provide written proof to the Animal Regulation Officer that the animal has been euthanized by a properly licensed veterinary clinic.
3. File with the Animal Regulation Officer a written request for a hearing before the Animal Advisory Committee to determine if the vicious declaration should be upheld.

The owner **may not** maintain possession of the animal during the hearing process and is responsible for all costs incurred.
