FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE CLARK COUNTY NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM THIRD ROUND (NSP3) SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT OF THE FY 2010 HUD ACTION PLAN FOR HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Clark County is proposing to amend its Neighborhood Stabilization Program Third Round (NSP3) plan for Federal NSP3 funding. We propose to re-allocate \$625,000 from the discontinued NSP3 Homebuyer Assistance Program in order to provide funding to the Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority. Funds will be used for the purchase, delivery and installation of manufactured housing units in the currently vacant Phase II of Rulon Earl Mobile Manor located at 3903 E. Stewart Avenue. This reallocation will provide for additional affordable rental housing opportunities for low-income senior citizens.

The NSP3 Substantial Amendment and Action Plan will be changed to reflect these proposed changes and submitted to HUD for approval.
