#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

- A. **Fred Doten** called the meeting to order 10:01am as a quorum was present
- B. The meeting was conducted in conformance with the Nevada Open Meeting Law.

- E. The Public Works Committee did not remove an item from the agenda or delay discussion relating to an item at any time.

#### 2. ORGANIZATIONAL ITEMS

Prior to discussing the agenda items **Fred Doten**

##### A. **Approval of the June 16, 2016 Agenda.**

**Shawn Escarzaga** moved and **John Pantages** seconded the approval of the agenda. Motion carried on a vote of 4 to 0.

##### B. **Approval of the Minutes of the April 21, 2016 Meeting**

**Shawn Escarzaga** moved and **Marty Knauss** seconded the approval of the April 21, 2016 minutes as written.. Motion carried on a vote of 4 to 0.

#### 3. COMMENTS BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC

There were no comments from the Public reference any of the agenda items.

#### 4. COMMITTEE BUSINESS

- A. **Receive an update on recent traffic studies in Laughlin and recent work orders submitted to Public Works and take any action Deemed appropriate.**

**Fred Doten** started the discussion by asking all to turn to the chart.

**No Sidewalk along Mesquite Lane.** **Fred Doten** noted that **Kaizad Yazdani** indicated that a walking path could be constructed on the north side of the road. **Fred Doten** said there was nothing new reference this decision. He hoped to discuss this next month with CCPW.

**“No Parking” Signs:** **Fred Doten** noted that he had received an email from **Kaizad Yazdani** that removing the 2-way left turn lane and replacing it with a single white line was in the planning. **Fred Doten** noted this couple be a topic for next month’s meeting.

**Restriping of white lines on Needles Hwy:** **Fred Doten** noted that he did not feel anything would be done to restripe Needles Highway, but that he was going to leave it on the list for the short term.

**Inoperable Street lights:** **Fred Doten** noted that there had been some delay in getting lights repaired; however, he feels progress was being made. He noted that overall CCPW was doing a great job in repairing nonoperational street lights. **Marty Knauss** commented that some of his reported lights had been on the list for a couple months, especially the one by the bridge. He felt it being hidden by tree may be a factor.

**New sign for Chamber Access Road:** **Fred Doten** said that to date nothing had been done reference installing these signs. He would follow up on this over the next month

**El Mirage Drainage at Banyon:** **Fred Doten** noted that **Kaizad Yazdani** had sent an email saying this erosion issue had been forwarded to engineering. **Fred Doten** said he needed to contact **Joe Yatson**.

**Stripping Coming Loose:** **Fred Doten** noted that there were additional strips coming loose at the Cougar/ Bruce Woodbury intersection. The only other issue is at the intersection of Thomas Edison with Hwy 163. **John Pantages** confirmed that as of this morning it still needed to be repaired. He also noted that CCPW had cut off the loose parts of striping at Cougar Drive

**Sign hidden on El Mirage:** **Fred Doten** noted that Public Works intended to move the sign out on the other pole; however, nothing had been done to date.

**Road Repair Priorities:** **Fred Doten** noted again that this priority listing had still not been addressed by the LTAB. He felt nothing would be provided in the short term on the status of road repair. This couple be a topic with CCPW.

**Erosion by Walking Path on El Mirage:** **Fred Doten** noted that he had not done anything on this issue but would have a status by the next meeting.

**Erosion on Bruce Woodbury:** **Fred Doten** noted that he had not submitted a paper on this issue. **Shawn Escarzaga** noted that they were backfilling with dirt when it washed out.

**Potholes at Intersection of Thomas Edison and Laughlin Civic Drive:** **Fred Doten** noted that he could not find them. **John Pantages** responded that they were quite small can could be easily missed.

- B. **Discuss Zone Inspections and take any action appropriate:** **Fred Doten** noted that the reports were being submitted and issues were slowly getting repaired. He noted that the committee just needed to continue pushing for things to get complete.

C. **Discuss having Clark County Public Works at our next meeting and agenda items.**

**Fred Doten** said he wanted to get Clark County Public Works personnel to our next meeting. He noted that it had been 6-7 months since the last time they were here. He also said that he had sent an email to **Kaizad Yazdani** asking if they could support the meeting.
