Clark County is currently taking applications for appointments to the Town Advisory Boards (TAB) and Citizens Advisory Council (CAC) for two year terms beginning January 5, 2015. TABs and CACs hold public meetings at least once a month. Applicants must be eligible to vote, live within the area encompassed by the TAB or CAC they are applying for and attend annual training.

TABs and CACs disseminate information to citizens as well as provide input to the Board of County Commissioners and Planning Commission on matters pertaining to town issues such as, long term planning, zoning, public works projects, new ordinances and community concerns.

IF ANY MEMBER OF THE BOARD WISHES TO EXTEND THE LENGTH OF A PRESENTATION, THIS WILL BE DONE BY THE CHAIRMAN, OR BY THE BOARD BY A MAJORITY VOTE. ALL COMMENTS BY SPEAKERS SHOULD BE RELEVANT TO THE BOARD ACTIVITY AND JURISDICTION.
