3. COMMITTEE BUSINESS

A. Receive a report from Trey Smith, Parks & Rec

Trey Smith reported that Session 3 Programs have some changes. Basketball will be changed to Tennis, a Yoga Extreme session will be on Saturdays and Wiffle Golf

will be a 6-week course at a 9 hole golf course.

Parents' Night Out will be held on April 25 at 6:00 P.M. Pre-registration is required with a \$5.00 per child entry fee. Movie in the Park will be on May 17.

Laughlin Aquatics Pool opens Memorial Day weekend, Lifeguard Class will be held at the end of April and beginning of May.

Senior trips for May will include: May 7th Bowling Trip to the Strike Zone at the Sunset Hotel & Casino, May 14th Shopping Trip in Las Vegas, and May 21st will be a Mystery Trip.

B. Receive a report from Pamela Walker

Pamela Walker reported she has made no progress with Las Vegas Parks and Recreation. If she writes a grant for Parks and Rec, the funds go to the county and then down to Laughlin.

4. COMMUNITY INPUT/ PUBLIC COMMENT

Noreen McBride reported that there have been many sick people up at the center. Trey Smith from Parks & Recreation stated that a sign is already posted. Also, Noreen McBride mentioned the Vending Machines at the Center need more of a variety of items.

A beach volleyball court is being planned and a 5K run in the fall. There is also a new Park Pass for the Disabled Veterans.
