SUMMARY – An ordinance amending Chapter 32 of Title 2 of the Clark County Code to impose an additional fee on the recording of certain documents by the county recorder with the proceeds used to provide legal services for abused and neglected children; and providing for other matters properly relating thereto.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 32 OF TITLE 2 OF THE CLARK COUNTY CODE TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL FEE ON THE RECORDING OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS BY THE COUNTY RECORDER WITH THE PROCEEDS USED TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES FOR ABUSED AND NEGLECTED CHILDREN; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISISONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of Title 2 of the Clark County Code is amended by the addition of a new section, as follows:

2.32.090 – Fee authorized to be charged and collected by county recorder for legal services for abused and neglected children.

(a) Pursuant to the authority granted to a board of county commissioners in Nevada Revised Statutes 247.305, subsection 4, as enacted by Assembly Bill 192 of the 76th Session of the Nevada Legislature, a fee of \$3.00 is imposed for the recording of a document, instrument, paper, notice, deed, conveyance, map, chart, survey, or any other writing in the office of the county recorder; except that no fee shall be charged under this section for recording the originally signed copy of a certificate of marriage described in Nevada Revised Statutes section 122.120 or for recording the declaration of value in relation to deeds evidencing a transfer of title to real property described in

Nevada Revised Statutes section 375.060. The fee imposed pursuant to this section shall be in addition to any other fee required by law.

(b) On or before the 5th day of each month, the county recorder shall pay the amount of fees collected by him or her pursuant to this section to the county treasurer. On or before the 15th day of each month, the county treasurer shall remit the money received from the county recorder to the organization operating the program for legal services for the indigent that receives the fees charged pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes 19.031 and Clark County Code section 2.32.040. All such fees must be used to provide legal services for abused and neglected children.

(c) The county recorder shall begin charging and collecting the additional fee imposed by this section on October 1, 2011.

SECTION 2. If any section of this ordinance or portion thereof is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining parts of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, clauses, phrases or sentences contained in the Clark County Code in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the publication thereof by title only, together with the names of the County Commissioners voting for or against its passage, in a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Clark County, Nevada, at least once a week for a period of two (2) weeks.
