1. The Bid opening date of September 18, 2013 at 3:00:00 p.m. **remains unchanged.**

ATTACHMENT 4 – AUDIOVISUAL SYSTEM REPLACEMENTS TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

2. Page 4-14, Part 2 – System and Equipment, **Add New Item No. 2.07 – Control System**, as follows:

2.07 CONTROL SYSTEM

- A. One control panel shall be found in the system, a rack-mounted one in the CATV Capture System equipment rack.
- B. The CATV Capture System shall allow the user to record news programs throughout the day from all of the local stations, KSNV, KVVU, KLAS, KLVX, KTNV, KINC, and KBLR onto DVD and onto the internal hard-disk drives of the DVD/HDD recorders. The user shall be able to set the DVD/HDD Recorders to timer record.
- C. From the control panel the user shall have the ability to control any of the DVD/HDD Recorders and the HDMI Switcher. At a minimum, through the control panel, the user shall have access to transport control, channel selection, power, and timer programming functions for the DVD/HDD Recorders and input selection on the HDMI Switcher. The user shall have the ability to set timer recording on all of the DVD/HDD Recorders. The user shall have the ability to set all of the DVD/HDD recorders to any of the available cable television channels. The user shall have the ability to access and perform transport control of content on the DVD and HDD units within the recorders. The user shall have the ability to dub content to and from the DVD and HDD units of each recorder. The control panel shall be password protected.
- D. Contractor shall coordinate button layout and page flips with owner prior to programming the system. Contractor shall submit control panel layouts and a narrative describing the functionality of the control panel to the owner and to the consultant for review, prior to programming the system.
- E. Contractor shall include in the cost of the system, one re-program of control panel layout and functionality should revisions to control panel functionality and look be required. Included in this shall be any control system programming revisions required to accommodate changes made to the control panel layout and functionality.

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QUESTION AND ANSWER

Q1: #21 Clear Com RS-602 is replaced by RS-702?

A1: **The RS-702 is not available, yet, and the availability date has not been determined by the manufacturer. The RS-602 is still a current model.**

Q2: If we use RS-602 we also need YS-36?

A2: **The YC-36 adapter cable isn't needed since our connections will be through 6-pin XLRs. Please refer to drawings, TA0.01 and TA0.02 for the six pin XLR call-outs.**

Q3: #57 Shure ULCD2 does not specify the capsule style?

A3: **Please utilize the SM-58 cartridge with the ULXD2 transmitters.**

Q4: #59 Shure ULXDHD is a dual not a quad, which is intended?

A4: **Please provide the quad receiver, the Shure ULXD4Q.**

Except as modified herein, all other Bid specifications, terms and conditions shall remain the same.
