SPECIAL PROVISION

SECTION 107 - LEGAL RELATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITY TO THE PUBLIC

1. Subsection 102.25, UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD (UPRR) TERM AND CONDITIONS (page 107-9),

Replace the section with the following:

No work shall be performed within UPRR right of way. No personnel or equipment shall encroach into the UPRR right of way.

2. **Delete** Appendix B in its entirety. Appendix B will not be used. Appendix C will remain the same and all references to Appendix C will remain the same.

- a) P30 pull box at Sta 190+75 (AW) (Note 1) is **revised** to be a Type 200 splice vault (Note 2) and **revised location** to be at Sta 191+41 (AV).
- b) Coil 60 feet of slack of 1-72 fiber optic cable into the splice vault (AW).
- c) Construction Note 14 is deleted from pull box AV to splice vault AW.

Sheet No. D-1: "Splice Location – Warm Springs RD Termination Point" Detail

- a) **Revision:** Do not connect Blue, Orange, Green, & Brown fibers to CDCA in traffic signal cabinet from Green tube heading from the west on Warm Springs.

This Attachment will be time stamped by the Purchasing and Contracts Division. I understand that submission after the two-hour time limit is not allowed and will be returned to me and the bid may be deemed non-responsive. I acknowledge that for:
 - a) Projects UNDER \$5,000,000
I need to list **only those Subcontractors** that will provide labor/improvements exceeding \$50,000.00.
5. I acknowledge that if notified that I am the low bidder, I must submit the Disclosure of Ownership/Principals form within 24-hours of request.
6. I acknowledge that my bid is based on the current State of Nevada prevailing wages and/or the current State and Federal wage rates, whichever is greater.
7. I acknowledge that I have not breached a public work contract for which the cost exceeds \$25,000,000, within the preceding year, for failing to comply with NRS 338.147 and the requirements of a contract in which I have submitted within 2 hours of the bid opening an Affidavit pertaining to preference eligibility.
8. Upon faxed or mailed receipt of a Notice of Intent to Award the Contract, I will provide the following submittals within seven business days from receipt of the Notice:
 - a) Performance Bond, Labor and Material Payment Bond and a Guaranty Bond, for 100% of the Contract amount as required.
