CLARK COUNTY DESERT CONSERVATION PROGRAM DE-COMMISSIONING AND RESTORATION

NEVADA STATE LABOR COMMISSION PWP NUMBER: CL-2014-42

SCOPE OF WORK:

- Project Overview:** Clark County desires to solicit bids from qualified Contractors to provide for de-commissioning or restoration services to linear disturbances on the Boulder City Conservation Easement (BCCE), as the desert habitat on the easement has been damaged by Off Highway Vehicles (OHV). The goal of this project is to restore disturbed sites on the BCCE to a condition intended to hide the disturbed area so that it will blend in with the surrounding habitat in an effort to discourage further OHV traffic and provide habitat for native species. Twenty (20) sites have been identified for restoration.
- MANDATORY Pre-Bid site inspection:** The Owner (Clark County) is requiring all contractors or potential bidders to attend a mandatory site inspection of all twenty (20) intrusion sites prior to submitting a bid for the proposed project. Each of the twenty sites will have an identifying stake (provided by Owner) at the start and end point so each potential bidder can visually see the limits of restoration required. County Project Manager will have the opportunity to give input for each site restoration and discuss any questions/issues bidders may have before the bid. Each site has a minimum width and length, see specifications. This site inspection Pre-Bid meeting will require at least five (5) hours time. Only one (1) Pre-Bid inspection meeting will be scheduled for potential bidders. The date and time of the mandatory Pre-Bid site inspection is set for October 4, 2013.
- Order of Importance:** The Clark County Desert Conservation Program has identified twenty (20) sites for de-commissioning and restoration. Funding for repair of Phase 2 is limited, therefore the sites have been prioritized 1-20 from highest to lowest in terms of interest for de-commission/restoration. Each bidder will provide a lump sum cost to restore each site individually. Sites 1-11 are of most importance. Sites 12-20 are of lesser importance at this time. It is the desire of the Owner to restore all sites on the list. Award will be determined by how many sites can be restored while remaining within the allotted budget.

ESTIMATED COST: \$266,500

A Mandatory Pre-bid Conference will be held on **OCTOBER 4, 2013 at 9:00 a.m.**, at the sites. If your firm is unfamiliar with the County Bid Submittal procedures and would like to obtain training on the submittal process for this Bid, please contact Thomas E. Boldt, Senior Purchasing Analyst, at tboldt@clarkcountynv.gov no later than **the Friday before the walk through**, and a training session will be provided immediately following the pre-bid conference referenced above.

Bids will be accepted at the Clark County Government Center, 500 South Grand Central Parkway, Purchasing and Contracts Division, Fourth Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89106, on or before **OCTOBER 11, 2013 at 2:15:00 p.m.**, based on the time clock at the Clark County Purchasing and Contracts front desk, and will be opened immediately thereafter. Bidders and other interested parties are invited to attend the Bid opening.
