ADDENDUM NO. 2

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

1. The RFP opening date of February 21, 2014 at 3:00:00 p.m. **remains unchanged.**

GENERAL CONDITIONS

2. Page 4, item No. 19 – Evaluation Criteria and Proposal Content, Paragraph C – Organizational Information: **Delete** subsection X in its entirety.
3. Page 6, item No. 19 – Evaluation Criteria and Proposal Content, Paragraph I – Compliance with the County's Standard Contract: **Delete** the said paragraph in its entirety.
4. Page 3, Item No.19 – Evaluation Criteria and Proposal Content: **Add** new paragraph K as follows:

Exhibit 1, Disclosure Statement – Complete and submit the attached Exhibit 1, Disclosure Statement form.

QUESTION AND ANSWER

- Q1: Is a Clark County Business License or Limited Vendor Business Registration required as a prerequisite to bidding, or can the appropriate license be obtained after the RFP selection process?
- A1: The Business or Registration license is not required at this time. The said licenses may be required prior to award of this effort, if deemed necessary by Clark County Business License Department.
- Q2: Where should the disclosure statement be included in our proposal?
- A2: Please see Item No. 3 above.
- Q3 (a): As customary with underwriting municipal securities, will the terms and conditions of the underwriting relationship between the County and the underwriter be governed by a "bond purchase agreement?"
- A3 (a): Yes. With respect to individual bond issues, the underwriting relationship between the County and the Underwriter will be governed by a bond purchase agreement.
- Q3 (b): If yes, will said bond purchase agreement contain provisions indemnifying the County? And will such indemnification provisions govern the underwriter's indemnity obligations with respect to the County notwithstanding Page 6, Section XII, Miscellaneous; Item E (Indemnity) of the Contract for Underwriting Services?

Q3 (b): In general the bond purchase agreements do not contain provisions under which the underwriter is required to indemnify the County.

Except as modified herein, all other Bid specifications, terms and conditions shall remain the same.
