QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

2. Q1. Our Therapeutic Foster Homes are licensed through DFS. We had spoken to Clark County Family Services several months ago about licensing, and received approval that we would be able to License our Residential Substance Abuse Program through them. Will that suffice for this contract, or will the County require licensing through the HCQC?

A1. Yes, DFS licensed home would be fine. Alternatively, the facility would be licensed by Dept. of Health.

Q2. I was able to access a copy of a Residential Treatment contract with another agency through the Clark County Commissioners website. It appears that the daily rate was \$118. Are you able to tell us if treatment services are included in that OR if that is the room and board and groups/individuals are billed separately.

A2. This is a new service for Department of Juvenile Justice Service and Providers should prepare their proposal accordingly. The \$118 was an established rate for another Department's contract, this is a new contract for Department of Juvenile Justice Service.
