ADDENDUM NO. 1

INVITATION TO BID

1. The Bid Opening date of August 12, 2014 at 2:15:00 p.m., **remains unchanged.**

GENERAL CONDITIONS

2. Section 2.2 SUBSTITUTIONS ("OR EQUAL") (beginning on page 2-5):

Paragraph B, Procedure:

Insert the following paragraphs between the current first paragraph and second paragraph:

"Should the Contractor wish to use any material, product, or service other than those specified by brand or trade name, after award of the contract but prior to the next contract renewal, or due to a discontinued product at any time, Contractor must submit to the Architect or Engineer, a written request for substitution accompanied by all data necessary for the Architect or Engineer to determine whether the requested substitution is equal to the specified material, product, or service. Prior to proposing any substitute material or product, Contractor shall verify that the material or product is listed on the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) Qualified Product List (QPL), latest edition, and that the material or product also meets Clark County Nevada specifications and requirements. The submission of a request to substitute a material, product, or service gives rise to no obligation on the part of the Owner to accept such substitute, or on the part of the Architect or Engineer to determine such substitute to be the equal of that specified.

For example, if LPM1200 polyurea is discontinued mid-year, Contractor may submit LPM5000 as a substitute but only if it appears on the NDOT QPL. If LPM5000 is not on the NDOT QPL, Owner still has a bid item HPS-5 polyurea that is approved for use so the Contractor would be required to use HPS-5. "

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

COVER

3. **Replace** the cover page with the attached.

SECTION 108 – PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS

4. Subsection 108.03 PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS (page 108-1),

Replace the third paragraph with the following:

One Work Order will be issued at one time, for multiple locations. Every effort will be made to issue a Work Order for locations of approximately one square mile. Occasionally, if a Work Order contains locations that are outside of the square mile area, no additional payment or compensation will be made. An example of a typical Work Order will designate approximately twenty (20) to forty (40) crosswalk replacements for the specific leg(s) of various intersections, and may also include replacements for stop bar, arrow legends, and miscellaneous work. Contractor shall refer to subsection 108.04 of these Special Provisions for limitation of operations.

SECTION 633 – PAVEMENT MARKERS

5. Subsection 633.01.01, GENERAL (page 633-1),

Add the following:

Ennis Model C80 Abrasion Resistant Raised Pavement Marker is an acceptable substitute for Ennis Model 911 Abrasion Resistant Raise Pavement Marker.

Except as modified herein, all other bid specifications, terms, conditions, and special provisions shall remain the same.
