REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

1. The RFP opening date of November 25, 2014 at 3:00:00 p.m. **remains unchanged.**

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

2. Q1 Is there a possibility of my company submitting a response to the RFP for only the safety portion or professional civil engineering of the online training? My company provides safety training for OSHA general industry and construction compliance and will be providing a few civil engineering drainage studies courses.

We will have a training center within 6 miles of the county government building (Valley view and Charleston) and will be offering English and Spanish in-person OSHA 10 and 30 classes each month. Therefore your workers can take the online classes or come out to the building and attend in person. We will be happy to provide a proposal for both. In addition, there will be specialty safety classes that add value if done in-person as workers will be able to check out the latest safety protection PPE, confined space, fall protection, Hazardous materials, trenching excavation, low and high voltage (example: fall protection gear, try it on and handle equipment that has failed). When it comes to safety, in-person training tends to provide better retention for the students and they are able to ask questions and interact with others in the class.

Therefore, I would like to propose splitting out the safety and civil engineering so we can provide a response to the RFP for only that portion.

- A1 Clark County is looking for a provider that can supply multiple content options. Our desired is not to have different suppliers for content option. However, we will consider all proposals received.

- Q2 This project looks right up our alley and we'd love to get it, but we do not currently have 24/7 support. Is that a deal breaker?

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A2 There is no requirement for 24/7 support in our requirements. We require 24/7 availability of the content, not necessarily 24/7 support.

Q3 Clark County is seeking responses to this RFP to provide skill and competency based training courses to its approximately 10,000 full and part-time employees. Such training should be both hosted and developed content.

Does this mean you're looking for already created courses? Or are you looking to have courses built to get into your SAP/SucessFactors LMS? Please let me know as we custom build the courses based on the need of the customer. I want to make sure we are clear on what it is you're looking for?

A3 We are looking for both. Also the ability to develop our own courses within the system/framework.

Q4 I saw that you have an RFP out right now for learning content. I was wondering if there would be interest in an actual LMS and content? Do you have a preexisting LMS? And if so is there any time in the future that you would be moving away from it to another vendor?

A4 We are currently implementing SAP SuccessFactors and there is no any plan to move away from it as we are just implementing it.
