

| 2.1 On sheet D-4 item #8 (Landscape Modification); the square footage shown on schedule, does not match the square footage shown on the drawings. Please clarify. | The intent is to cover the square footage of the limits of construction at the project site. This would include both removal and repair and reestablishment of landscape areas. The #8 quantity is for information purposes only and is not a bid item. The #8 area has been updated with Addendum #1 to reflect the additional construction area. |
| 2.2 On sheet D-4 what is the on center spacing required for the shrubs that are to be put back in place? | Please match the existing spacing of shrubs on site. |
| 2.3 On sheet D-4 there is existing turf in this area, but it is not called out on the drawings. With the amount of demo work being done, it is most likely to be damaged and will need to be replaced. Should we replace this turf? | The contractor is to repair and replace the landscaping in-kind to the extent of construction. In the case that existing turf is damaged by construction it would need to be repaired or replaced at no additional charge to Clark County. The type of turf or grass is called out in the Landscape Replacement and Repair Table on sheet D-4. |
| 2.4 On sheet D-5 item #8 (Landscape Modification); the square footage shown on schedule, does not match the square footage shown on the drawings. Please clarify. | The intent is to cover the square footage of the limits of construction at the project site. This would include both removal and repair and reestablishment of landscape areas. The #8 quantity is for information purposes only and is not a bid item. The #8 area has been updated with Addendum #1 to reflect the additional construction area. |

- 2.6 On sheet D-7 & D-8 (this work is located in front of the Mirage), the existing landscape in these areas are heavily planted with existing large specimen trees and palms. The drawings do not indicate if these are to be removed. Can we get a clarification on this?
- The bid items for the details includes Landscape Modification which is the work and materials necessary to complete the construction in place. This work includes removals, plantings, and everything necessary to reestablish and retain the existing theme and character of the landscaped area within the project construction limits.
- 2.7 On sheet D-7 & D-8 (this work is located in front of the Mirage),
- Landscaping is to match the landscaping in kind as found today on the project site. It is in the intent of the design contract documents to retain the existing theme and character.
- 2.8 On sheet D-7 & D-8 (this work is located in front of the Mirage), item #8 (Landscape Modification); the square footage shown on schedule, does not match the square footage shown on the drawings. Please clarify.
- The intent is to cover the square footage of the limits of construction at the project site. This would include both removal and repair and reestablishment of landscape areas. The #8 quantity is for information purposes only and is not a bid item. The #8 area has been updated with Addendum #1 to reflect the additional construction area.
