#### INVITATION TO BID

1. The Bid opening date of August 6, 2015 at 3:00:00 p.m. **remains unchanged.**

#### BID FORM (Revised per Addendum No. 2)

2. Group 5 – VMS Equipment as Needed, page IV-6, Item No. 102, 103, 104, 105: **delete** reference to “29 MP” and **replace** with “4K 8 Megapixel”. (additional instructions: Bidder should make the changes, which are identified in bold/italic, to the Bid Form in the following fashion and initial: “**3-MP** Camera – Ceiling Mount **4k 8 Mp**”
3. Page IV-12, Attachment to Bid Form: **delete** Item No.5 – Copy of Successful Bidder’s surety bond in its entirety.

4. Exhibit C, Division 28 23 00, page 282300-11, Item No. 2.6: paragraph J, **add** subsection Item No.18 as follows:  
  
18. IR LED/Viewable Length      12 ea/30 mm (98.43ft)
5. Exhibit H Bid Form Supplement Revised per Addendum No.2, Item No. 102, 103, 104, 105: **delete** reference to “29 MP” and **replace** with “4K 8 Megapixel”. (additional instructions: Bidder should make the changes, which are identified in bold/italic, to the Bid Form in the following fashion and initial: “**3-MP** Camera – Ceiling Mount **4k 8 Mp**”

#### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS (unanswered from Addendum no.3)

- Q2. Please provide any available information on the legacy Honeywell system – number and types of existing cameras, locations with existing Honeywell video equipment, recording devices and cameras at these locations. This information is being requested to gain a better understanding of existing platform to provide best pricing to support legacy equipment.
- A2. The County’s legacy system primarily consist of Honeywell NTSC analog cameras with Honeywell Rapid Eye DVRs.

- Q3. How many locations in total does the county expect to migrate to the new VMS/camera system?  
A3. The County expects to migrate the three current locations identified within the Bid and a funded program is available for three more locations, which may be subject to change. Additional locations will be added as funding becomes available.
- Q5. Can the county identify how many remote sites currently have security and surveillance or that they anticipate will?  
A5. There are approximately three remote sites with security and surveillance systems. Additional locations may be added as funding becomes available.
- Q7. Video Management System General Specifications 2.19. C 2. The login name shall appear on the main screen along with the name of the user currently logged in. *Is it acceptable if the web client does show this info?*  
A7. This option will be discussed after the bid has been awarded.
- Q8. Video Management System General Specifications 2.19. F 5. The VMS shall allow the user to export unlimited number of cameras in multiple formats to multiple destinations. *Is it acceptable if the client exports to two destinations at once: a file path and a media tray such as a cd burner. Once it has been exported it can be moved/copied to as many places as necessary.*  
A8. This option can be discussed after the bid has been awarded.
- Q9. Exhibit B Part I 1.1, N 9. Evidence exportation with Drivers *Does the county accept a web client for live, playback, and export with all administrative and diagnostic functions done Management Client side?*  
A9. Yes, County shall have authorized administration rights.
- Q10. Exhibit B Part I 1.1, O. The VMS software Administration management shall include but not limited to: Viewing live images, viewing recorded images, exporting images, setting up cameras/ NVR/Servers, generating and modifying groups and users. *Does the county allow for viewing of live video, setting up cameras, servers and modifying groups and users on the Management Client and playback on a smart client, web client and web client?*  
A10. Yes, County shall have authorized administration rights.
- Q27. Exhibit B Part I 1.1. K. The VMS software shall support High Definition Stream Management by reducing the required client bandwidth and processing it by only transmitting what is necessary to view the video stream at full quality. HDSM is exclusive to Avigilon, and only then if one is using Avigilon Cameras. This does not coincide with the county's request to have an open VMS platform. Would the County accept a VMS that allows separate high and low definition streams to be set up, and users can switch between them as necessary to manage bandwidth? At least one VMS does this and supports 4,000 camera models.  
A27. All VMS manufacturers have a version of HDSM and at different levels of software utilization.
