ADDENDUM NO. 1

INVITATION TO BID

1. The Bid Opening date of May 21, 2015 at 3:00:00 p.m., **remains unchanged.**

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

2. **Add** Paragraph 7, Maximum Delivery Time, (page III-1):

Maximum delivery time is forty-five (45) calendar days upon notification of order. Failure to offer a delivery time within the maximum number of days specified may be considered a substantial deviation and be cause for rejection. Time is of the essence and failure to meet the delivery time specified shall constitute a breach of contract.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

3. Section 1, General, (pages IV-1 through IV-2):

Paragraph B, Base Metal Pretreatment (page IV-1):

Add the following:

- i) Owner reserves the right to inspect solution strengths if there is a problem with the materials provided and delivered. However, it is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that the metal manufacturer or distributor comply with the requirements specified in RTC Standard Specifications.

Paragraph E, Sign Identification:

Replace Sentences b and c with the following:

b) The color of the identification (text) in the border area shall be the same color as the retroreflective sheeting, except of Stop and Yield signs. For the Stop and Yield signs, the identification (text) shall be in white at the edge of the red part of the sign at the bottom of the sign.

c) All finished signs and blank sign with retroreflective sheeting on one side only shall have a permanent identification mark or tag on the back of each aluminum sign, on the lower left hand corner when facing the rear of the sign. The marking shall identify the manufacturer of the sign face, and the year the sign was manufactured. The manufacturer identification mark shall not exceed 4.50-inch in length and 2.25-inch in width.

Paragraph F, Warranty:

Replace Paragraph F in its entirety with the following:

- a) The retroreflective sheeting shall be considered unsatisfactory and failing if it has deteriorated due to natural cause to the extent that one or more of the following is true:

- The values for the coefficients of retroreflection for sheeting are less than 50 percent of the required values for the same sign when new in accordance with ASTM D4956, latest edition.
- The sign material's integrity or adhesion to the sign substrate has substantially failed.

b) Contractor shall replace, at no additional cost to the Owner, any finished sign(s), except for fluorescent orange color signs, that have failed within the life of this contract including any contract renewals, or three (3) years from acceptance of the materials, whichever comes later.

c) Contractor shall replace, at no additional cost to the Owner, any fluorescent orange color finished signs that have failed within one (1) years from acceptance of the materials.

Add Section I, Sign Detail:

a) The actual artwork will not be provided for each sign. This shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

b) If a standard MUTCD sign is ordered, the sign designation and size will be provided. It is the responsibility of the contractor to find the corresponding detail(s) in Standard Highway Signs book, which is available online at http://mutcd.fhwa.dot.gov/ser-shs_millennium.htm

c) If a County special sign is ordered, the sign designation and size will be provided. It is the responsibility of the contractor to find the corresponding detail(s) in Technical Specifications pages IV-4 through IV-10.

4. Section 2, MUTCD Standard Signs with Retroreflective Sheeting and Anti-Graffiti Film, (page IV-2 through IV-3):

Add the following:

Bid item 2.1 will be paid per square foot of the finished sign panels delivered. This includes signs that are square, rectangular, diamond, or circular in shape.

Bid item 2.2 will be paid per square foot of the finished sign panels delivered. This includes 30", 36", or 48" stop signs.

Bid item 2.3 will be paid per each finished sign panel delivered. This includes the 36"x36" pentagon shaped M1-6 County Route Sign, as shown on page IV-10 of the Technical Specifications.

5. Section 3, Blank Signs with Retroreflective Sheeting on One Side, (page IV-3):

Add the following:

Bid item 3.1 will be paid per square foot of the sign panels delivered. This includes signs that are rectangular in shape.

6. Section 4, Blank Signs with Retroreflective Sheeting on Both Sides, (page IV-3):

Add the following:

Bid item 4.1 will be paid per square foot of the sign panels delivered. This includes signs that are rectangular in shape.

7. Section 5, School Area Signs with Retroreflective Sheeting and Anti-Graffiti Film, (page IV-3):

Add the following:

Bid items 5.1 through 5.6 will be paid per each finished sign panel delivered.

Bid item 5.3, School Speed Limit Sign includes the following signs:

- a) MUTCD S5-1 sign for 15 mph
- b) MUTCD S5-1 sign for 25 mph
- c) County school speed limit sign for 15 mph (page IV-9 of the Technical Specifications)
- d) County school speed limit sign for 25 mph (page IV-9 of the Technical Specifications)


8. **Add Section 6, Miscellaneous Items (page IV-3):**

Owner will request for a cost proposal for sign(s) that are not covered in items 2.1 through 5.6. Contractor shall submit a cost proposal within seven (7) calendar days upon request. Owner will review the costs, and approve or reject the proposal within seven (7) calendar days. Prices have to be agreed upon by both the Owner and Contractor before signs are made. Contractor shall not proceed with making any signs until written approval by the Owner is received.

CLARIFICATIONS ONLY – NO REVISIONS

- 9. Contractors shall refer to Technical Specifications, Section 1 on page IV-1 through IV-2 for sheeting requirements. There are two (2) Type XI sheeting manufacturers approved by Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT). Contractor shall comply with manufacturer's recommendation on direct print or cut vinyl on their sheeting.
- 10. The intent of this contract is to order traffic signs for replacement of existing damaged or missing signs. The sign sizes, sign designations, speed limit (if applicable) and quantities shall be as specified in each order.
- 11. Contractors shall refer to Technical Specifications, Section 2 on pages IV-2 through IV-3 for bid items 2.1 through 2.3.
- 12. Contractors shall refer to Technical Specifications, Section 3 on page IV-3 for bid item 3.1.
- 13. Contractors shall refer to Technical Specifications, Section 4 on page IV-3 for bid item 4.1.
