ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS CONTRACT FOR PAINT AND PAINT SUPPLIES REVISED PER ADDENDUM NO. 1

Name of Firm

INTENT:

It is the intent of these specifications to provide Products that will conform to the specifications, and be suitable for continuous use by COUNTY. The Products offered shall be new, unused, the current production model and conform to the specifications provided below.

The Products shall comply with all Federal and State of Nevada Emission Control Regulations, and Safety Standards in effect at the time of delivery to COUNTY.

These specifications shall be construed as minimum requirements. Should the manufacturer's current published data or specifications exceed these, they shall be considered as minimum and be furnished by Bidder.

BIDDERS MUST RETURN THE ORIGINAL OR A PHOTOCOPY OF THIS FORM AND MAKE AN ENTRY FOR EACH SPECIFICATION IN THE SPACE PROVIDED OPPOSITE THE SPECIFICATIONS, INDICATING ANY VARIANCES IN THE SPECIFICATION. IF THERE IS NOT ENOUGH SPACE, ATTACH AN ADDITIONAL SHEET OF PAPER.

1. The following Technical Specifications are applicable to Bid Form Item No. 1 through 6, unless **OTHERWISE** noted.
2. Unless otherwise noted, water-base paint shall be an exterior grade, architectural acrylic co-polymer flat or low luster finish product.
3. All colors and tints shall be UV-resistant.
4. COUNTY Standard Paint Product requirements:
 - A. Vista Duratone Flat Acrylic paint; Pastel (for whites, light tones, neutrals) and Deep (for medium to dark tones) tint bases.
 - B. Vista Acriglo Semi-Gloss paint; hi-hide white
 - C. Vista Duraglide Flat Acrylic Paint; white and mid tone tint base
5. Colors in acrylic base, currently in use by COUNTY, which may be subject to change, are as follows :
 - A. IDAHO GRAY- an Off-White
 - B. INTIMATE WHITE- an Off-White
 - C. BUFF YELLOW – a pastel beige/yellow
 - D. PHANTOM GRAY – a pastel cinder block light gray
 - E. ADOBE BROWN– slump-stone tan; a mid-tone
 - F. SANDSTONE- a rose block mid Mid-tone base
 - G. HI HIDE WHITE
 - H. SHADED PORCH- an Off-White beige
 - I. PEWTER WORKS- a mid-tone gray
6. The SUCCESSFUL BIDDER shall furnish the COUNTY with a copy of their standard-color palette (fan-decks) for the COUNTY'S reference. Though the colors listed above are most generally used, on occasion the COUNTY may request a custom match or other color variation.

7. The following services shall be provided at no additional costs to the COUNTY: colors ordered shall be matched to color chips, cards, samples, etc., maintaining color quality and integrity from one batch to another or one product to another. Paint that is received from SUCCESSFUL BIDDER may be returned for adjustment (at SUCCESSFUL BIDDER'S expense), if the tint does not match the color ordered, based on prior data supplied by the COUNTY.
8. Though one type of paint may be better suited to certain substrates than another, all paint will be used in a variety of situations and similar applications. All paint shall be used to cover graffiti (*Item No. 1 – 6*) on bare or previously painted surfaces which include the following substrates: Concrete and Cinder Aggregate Block, Concrete, Brick, Stucco, Metal, Masonite, Wood, Plywood, Drywall, Plaster, and others.
9. Besides meeting or exceeding the specified analysis included in the Bid Proposal, all high quality grade paint shall (Bid Form Item No.1 through 4) be of a quality and texture capable of hiding most graffiti markings (bleeders excluded) using one coat (production grade paint will be two coat requirement, Bid Form Item No.5 and 6) of paint on substrates noted above, without primer or other preparatory coatings. Paint shall be amenable to application by brush, roller, or airless spraying methods and techniques.
10. Water-base paint shall have an approximate spreading rate of **300 to 400** square feet per gallon, depending on surface conditions.
11. Although actual curing time may be longer, each coat of paint shall be dry to the touch in approximately thirty (30) minutes, at 75° Fahrenheit, and 25% humidity.
12. Water-base paint shall have a **180** calendar day's shelf life ***without showing abnormal separation of the paint when not stirred, shaken, or mixed. COUNTY at its sole discretion will determine what is considered normal and abnormal separation of the paint.***
13. All non-aerosol water-base paint shall exhibit the following characteristics:
 - A. Titanium Dioxide as a pigment ingredient (for white-tone base) shall be in more concentration than any other pigment ingredient, or other pigment ingredients combined.
 - B. Other than small amounts of Ethylene Glycol, no other toxic liquid chemical compound shall be present in hazardous quantity.
 - C. Ethylene Glycol content in water-based paint shall be 2% weight, or less.
 - D. Acrylic resin content (by weight) shall be noted rather than "acrylic emulsion".
