Questions / Answers

1. How many hours per day does the OB anesthesiologist perform inpatient duties? (how many hours on average per 24 hours is he/she working ,not sitting in a call room with the pager)
A: I do not have an answer for this. We do not monitor their downtime. We did have 1756 Epidurals; 743 Spinals and 27 patients with general anesthesia.
2. How many OB Anesthesia physicians are typically in-house per 24 hours?
A: Currently there is 1 OB Anesthesiologist 24 hrs with 2nd OB Anesthesiologist from 7a – 7p and 3rd on call for backup in 30 minutes.
3. Will you release all of the responders' submitted questions and your reply from this Q&A segment?
A: Yes
4. Are we responsible for any GYN procedures? If so please provide volume, case types, etc...
A: GYN is not typically done on L&D however it could happen.
5. How is your anesthesia service provided for the Main ORs? Does the same group currently provide coverage for L&D as well?
A: OB anesthesia exclusively serves L&D.
6. Describe your motivation for making a change to your current OB anesthesia services.
A: Under NRS 332, UMC is required to compete contracts over \$50,000.00.
7. What coverage model is currently being utilized in L&D? Describe your mix of MD to CRNA if applicable.
A: No CRNAs currently.
8. Would an all CRNA model be considered to cover L&D?
A: Possibly
9. How many C-Section rooms are there physically? What is their proximity to the Main ORs?
A: 2 ORs in L&D on 7th floor, Main OR is on 1st floor directly off of same bank of elevators used by L&D.
10. How many C-Sections require anesthesia involvement on a daily basis?
A: Not sure what the real question is here: All C-sections have some type of anesthesia.
11. What is the daily volume for scheduled C-Sections?
A: There are 4 *scheduled* C-section slots per day.
12. Are VBACs performed and if so how many annually?
A: Yes. 146 attempted

13. Number of labors converted to C-section w/ Epidural?

A: We do not track these numbers

14. Number of labors converted to C-Section w/ spinal?

A: We do not track these numbers
