1. **WS-0821-15 – CHRISTOFFERSEN, JOHN & TINA: WAIVER OF DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS** for a reduced setback for a building addition (garage and loft) in conjunction with a single family residence on 1.2 acres in an R-E (Rural Estates Residential) (RNP-I) Zone. 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3. **VS-0880-15 – PANIAGUA, PABLO: VACATE AND ABANDON** easements of interest to Clark County located between El Campo Grande Avenue and La Mancha Avenue, and between Dapple Gray Road and Campbell Road within Lone Mountain (description on file). 4. **UC-0842-15 – FLORES, LUIS: USE PERMIT** to allow a proposed accessory structure (wall) prior to a principal structure on 0.9 acres in an R-E (Rural Estates Residential) Zone.
