Family Dollar fell through due to the price of fire protection but she intends to reach out again. The helicopter in question flying around Sandy Valley is Valley Electric scoping for the Optic Line. Terrible Herbst is still working on their traffic study, and she will update us as it progresses. Peace Park will have their Design Review for improvements next week and it should be completed by next year. The questioned markers in the pass are from Public Works discussing with BLM about Columbia Pass and its improvements. Sara Avila resigned from the Board due to her employment requirements. There will be a position open to finish the term, applications on the County website.
