### VIII. ACTION ITEM

- A. Discussion and Action to make final recommendation on 30% completion of Bunkerville Trail System. *JP Woyton, Parsons- Consultant for County; Ray Kilmer, Clark County- Principal Engineer; Ron Gregory, Clark County Planner- assists in SNPLMA grants, etc.; were all present for the discussion. Two options for discussion tonight are: 1) going from Mesquite Bridge to cemetery and stopping, or 2) do all the rest of town, as previously discussed. No one has discussion regarding stopping at the cemetery- that option is out. The project is currently at 30% design, after the TAB meeting in July they reviewed and tried to incorporate all comments. Two schemes are being proposed 1) Right of Way (ROW) on both sides, plan shows 5 foot minimum from edge of pavement to 6 foot path in town. This scheme won't affect property owners with trees, plants, fences, etc in ROW. 2) Being that items are in county's ROW, if they move the path to edge of county property and between road and path there would be a place for parallel parking. Trail will most likely have to meander, and in the occasion there's not room for parking then parallel parking would be omitted. The trail has been added around the park perimeter. No lights are in plan; TAB's concern is trail along highway without any lights. Kilmer has talked with Public Works and was told to investigate option for lighting. There was much discussion and questions regarding*

options of the trail.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of people present were against the trail through town, others in attendance were for. Mesquite Bridge to school has already been approved from BLM. **WAITE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE PLAN TO RUN THE BUNKERVILLE TRAIL SYSTEM FROM RIVERSIDE ROAD TO SARAH SHANNON ALONG THE HIGHWAY ONLY, NOT WITHIN TOWN LIMITS WITH THE POSSIBILITY OF LIGHTS. UNLESS CONSTRAINTS BY COUNTY FROM ENTRANCE OF VIRGIN STREET; THEN APPROVE FROM THE BRIDGE TO THE CEMETERY. MOTION PASSED, UNANIMOUS.**

- Brian asked why the restrictions of hours have been put on the splash pad, when it was originally put in there were to be no time restrictions; if it is a drainage problem they need to know so it can be fixed.
- Members of the community thanked the board and the county for their efforts on the trail system.
- Don Paff asked the board to keep a walkway around the park as a priority for Bunkerville.
- Marianne reminded everyone in attendance that town board applications were available and due November 19.
