VI. ACTION ITEM

- A. Recognition of Don Lienberger. *Marianne introduced the principal at Bowler Elementary School, Mr. Wilson, he recognized Mr. Lienberger as an outstanding volunteer of his personal time. He has removed the weeds from around the school, cleaned the highway, helped at the school with odd jobs, etc. He is a great asset and is much appreciated. Marianne presented Mr. Lienberger with a proclamation signed by the County Commissioner for his volunteer work. **NO ACTION.***
- B. Presentation with Possible Action on 30% completion of design review of Bunkerville Trail System. *J.P. Woyton with Parsons who is the consultant for Clark County presented the design. Ray Kilmer, Civil Engineer Clark County Public Works and Jack Sjostrom, Parson's Project Manager for Bunkerville Trail were also present for the discussion. After receiving comments in July's meeting and working to incorporate what they could; they have reached 30%. They have added the trail to go around the perimeter of the park like requested. No lights are available because of maintenance issues, but the TAB asked if they could ask again for smaller lights or solar lights. After much discussion the TAB decided to hold their special call meeting to make a final recommendation on the trail. One of the following will be decided on: 1) Accept the trail as presented; 2) Keep the route as designed along SR170 and the park, but not through town (only if allowable with SNPLMA funding); 3) Keep the route as designed along SR170 but not at all in town. **NO ACTION TAKEN, ITEM TABLED FOR TWO WEEKS.***
- C. Discussion and Action on the position suggested by the Public Lands Conservation Committee for the management of public lands. *Don Paff & Elise McAllister presented the TAB with a position paper of the Public Lands Conservation Committee (PLCC). Which is an organization formed to give a public voice to Clark County residents who support public access and multiple use of our public lands while also ensuring common-sense*

This paper is regarding the Gold Butte land designation issue, the PLCC would like to see more activity from the legislature with the community members or rural areas. This paper represents the goals wanted from the rural area's regarding Gold Butte. Many in attendance supported the document. **LEAVITT MADE A MOTION TO APPOINT DUANE MAGOON TO BE THE BUNKERVILLE TAB REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PLCC AND TO SUPPORT THE POSITION OF THE PLCC. MOTION PASSED, UNANIMOUS**
