COMMUNITY CONCERNS

Phillip Regeski of PR Engineering, representing the Pioneer Saloon, attended the CAC meeting. He has a letter of approval from the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection to construct the wastewater system. There are questions regarding the exact acreage owned by the Pioneer Saloon owner. The construction of the wastewater system needs to be completed by Sept. 8, 2010 per the approval letter. The owner of the Pioneer Saloon has moved a large trailer to the back of the property, which is being used for storage. This will need to be permitted. Chris will pursue this matter. The patio and shade cover in back have been permitted. Serving drinks outside has not been permitted. Public Response needs to follow up on these items. JMS Contractors is the licensed Contractor, license # 33816-A, Class B-2. His phone number is 731-9566. The use permit will come back for a formal review in November 2010. Phil will come back to the CAC meeting in November unless everything is finished.

CORRESPONDENCE

STAFF REPORTS

Our new clock will be available after July 1.

Sgt. Greg Weeks from Metro is retiring July 1. Sgt. Joe Gibbons will take his place. Chris will invite him to come to the July meeting to introduce himself and discuss community concerns.

New legislation passed in 2009 prohibits the disposal of car tires in land fills. The Health District has implemented regulations outlining how the tires should now be recycled. Republic Services, on behalf of the outlying areas, is working with the County and the Health District to seek an exemption for the remote rural areas.

Commissioner Steve Sisolak attended the TAB/CAC Chairs Meeting and thanked everyone for their help. The following presentations were made at the meeting. Nevada Energy will be putting smart meters on every house in the near future. Nancy Lipski talked about the new Planning cycle. Park Police said there is a new agreement between Clark County and Metro Police Department for Metro to take over policing most of the urban parks, as well as rural parks. Public Response spoke about the new spay and neuter ordinance now in effect.

The window in the kitchen will be fixed after July 1.

The faucet outside is leaking into the kitchen.

The sod removal project should be finished by the end of July.

Chris will put in a work order to spray for ants.
