COMMUNITY CONCERN

Kevin Smedley and Paul Doerr of Comprehensive Planning attended to discuss South County Land Plan. Brite Source would like to use property currently zoned Residential Countryside for storage of construction materials and equipment. They would have to come before the CAC and Planning Commission to get a temporary use permit. Rails to Trails project would not be specifically detailed in the South County Plan since it is primarily BLM lands, but the policies can make reference to its importance. In the General Policies, CD 1-6 refers to the different Community Districts, with District 1 having areas such as Primm, Laughlin, possibly Jean, etc. that are in outlying areas with limited resources. It was suggested that people having historical buildings on their property should be rewarded with a tax incentive.

We would like to have some sort of public transportation come to Goodsprings.

Goodsprings Volunteer Fire Department capital expenditure priorities were discussed. Rick Niebel said the department needs a water tender truck that is at least 3000 gallons of water. They could use more volunteers and EMT's. The station needs a 4th door. The Goodsprings rescue unit went to Sandy Valley due to lack of EMT's. They have been talking about having an open house to recruit more people. They have a meeting the 1st Wednesday of each month. Ruth Rawlinson made a motion for the County to provide a 3000 gallon water tender, a rescue unit when EMT requirements are met, and a 4th roll up door for the station. Monica 2nd (5-0)

Proposed action on Hidden Hills Transmission Line will affect Goodsprings tremendously by: impact traffic, view, Old Spanish Trail, etc.

CORRESPONDENCE

CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBER REPORTS

Monica said the road next to the saloon has been held up because the NDOT permit expired and needs to be renewed. Precision Paving is doing the work. The new septic tank has not been finalized yet.

No one has been able to get hold of the man in charge of the Ghost Hunters. There has still been some ghost hunting activity between 8-9 p.m.

Ruth Rawlinson was asked to make a cake for the Old Timers Reunion which is May 5-6.

The foot race and motor cycle race that passed through Goodsprings did not stay on the designated trails. There was a lot of traffic through town and Wilson Pass.

It was suggested BLM try to have some dust control on the dry lake bed. Chris will try to discuss this with the BLM and County Air Quality representatives.

The freeway construction causes a white out at night. Chris will look into this with NDOT.

STAFF REPORTS

Chris talked to the School District concerning cleaning responsibility for the community center. He is waiting for a response.

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Four 'no trespassing' signs have been ordered for the cemetery.

A new 55 mph sign has been replaced on westbound Highway 161 just past the Shell station.

Three flood lights on the Post Office have not been fixed yet but a work order was submitted.

There have not been any additional lights put up near the Sloan interchange yet. Some new stripping has been done.
