### **COMMUNITY CONCERN**

Mary and Jessie Robinson, and Pat and Jeri Pinkerton will conduct the auction, take care of the paperwork and collect the payments for the items.

### **CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBER REPORTS.**

Liz Warren testified at the evidentiary hearing for the Hidden Hills Solar Energy Generating System, a Bright Source solar project at the California-Nevada border near Tecopa. All infrastructure (transmission towers, natural gas pipeline, access roads) will be sited in Nevada. The pipeline will intersect the Kern River Pipeline just north of Goodsprings, cross the Spring Mts. at Wilson's Pass, and pass through the length of Sandy Valley to serve this project. Transmission towers will be built along the existing transmission corridor through Sandy Valley, across the mountains, and through Goodsprings Valley to connect existing lines that serve California via Eldorado Dry Lake. All power will be sent to California; no power is dedicated to Nevada. The project will severely impact the Old Spanish National Historic Trail, and the Old Spanish Trail Association is requesting that Bright Source mitigate this impact for the life of its project (30 years) by funding a stationery display at the Shoshone Muneum, a mobile museum van to travel to schools, special events, i.e. fairs, etc. and also fund a video on the Old Spanish Trail.

### **STAFF REPORTS**

Nothing has been heard regarding fixing the roof.

The County has not heard from Metro regarding a report from BLM on the unauthorized use of the Sloan area for target shooting.

### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Liz Warren asked if the County would be willing to add the Goodsprings School's discharge to the existing septic system that serves this community center. The leach field for the existing school septic system passes under San Pedro to the private property across the road, the use of which costs the CCSD more than \$1500 annually. Since both of these are low use buildings, perhaps the community center system could accommodate the school use. She suggested the Goodsprings Historical Society could be approached to fund the change. Meggan will contact the appropriate County offices to investigate the feasibility of this proposal.
