Silver State South Phase II will be heard by County Commission July 30<sup>th</sup> on hold over use permits for the generation station around Primm and California border. It is regarding a waiver to to eliminate landscaping and on site paving. We believe this project could impact our water. We believe the electricity is for California use and does not benefit Nevada at all. They use primarily California workers on the project.

Meggan spoke to Bronson Mack of the Las Vegas Water District who owns the water rights for Jean. Two years ago Silver State went into an agreement with Las Vegas Water District to assure they would have enough water for their project. They can use 21 acre feet per year. Silver State has drilled a well and they may drill up to 3 to 5 more if needed. Liz Warren made a motion that the CAC would like to recommend the County not make a decision until a thorough hydrology report for Goodsprings and the Ivanpah basin has been completed. Warren/Beisecker (5-0). Meggan will type up a proposal to go to the Comprehensive Planning.

### **STAFF REPORTS**

Meggan contacted the School District regarding questions on the septic system for the school. Clark County Real Property Management said the cost of a sump pump would far exceed the \$1500 per year that the School District is paying. A request was made for person from Real Property Management to come to the CAC meeting.

The clean up and grading across from the Pioneer Saloon raised questions. The Air Quality has no jurisdiction on less than ¼ acre.

The ATV rentals have a business license. They can ride on the road up to 1 mile to a trail. Officer Vershall will look deeper into the law. He suggested whenever a problem occurs to call 311 to form an event number.
