## **COMMUNITY CONCERN**

Deb Dauenhauer from the Southern Nevada Transportation Coalition discussed starting bus transportation from Goodsprings and Sandy Valley to Las Vegas. Southern Nevada Transportation funded ½ of the money and the Federal Government funded the other ½. October 1<sup>st</sup> is the new year funding. They have 50 vehicles in their fleet. They will run 2 days a week and a third trip on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month to Las Vegas. Seniors, 60 and older ride on a donation base. Handicapped and others will be \$8 from Goodsprings. Personal care attendants and service animals are free. Children can ride with adults. Seniors go door to door for medical appointments. They will leave Goodsprings 8:30 a.m. They are hiring a driver for approximately 20 hours per week with an additional trip on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month at \$10 per hour. They are trying to get started between November 1<sup>st</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup>.
