CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBER REPORTS

Questions were brought up about the Solar Project in Primm. Chris is going to attend a meeting Wednesday with Commissioner Brager to discuss the Solar Project in Primm. The project will receive 2400 acre feet of water per year for 4 years. When finished building they will get 4 acre feet of water per year. There is a concern whether this will affect the water level and wells in Goodsprings. Chris will talk to the Water Authority to see if someone will come to our next meeting.

The Ragnar Relay Race preparations are moving along. Plans have been drawn up for parking along the streets in town. The runners will be coming up the power line road and turning down the by-pass road. The runners will be coming through town between 1 -4 a.m. An exchange will be set up at Highway 160 and Sandy Valley road to sell pancakes. There will be s'mores sold at the park in Goodsprings. Las Vegas Blvd. will be closed between Sloan and Jean. Proceeds from the event will be put in an account set up under the Public Education Foundation under Clark County School District for the Goodsprings Elementary School to help pay for the maintenance bills for the school.

Yellow Pines Rails to Trails is hoping for funding from the SNPLMA, Round 12 to move forward with Phase 1 of the project.
