

PROPOSED SMALL RIDE EXEMPTION IN CLARK COUNTY



Clark County Development Services will conduct a free public workshop on Wednesday, June 29, 2011, to discuss a proposed amendment to the Clark County Building Administrative Code that would exempt certain small amusement rides from the current requirement to obtain a ride permit to install and operate the ride. Small rides exempted by this amendment would not be required to pass Clark County safety inspections.

This workshop is open to ride operators, arcade owners, retail mall leasing agents, ride designers, third-party amusement ride inspection agencies, ride inspectors, the general public and any other personnel interested in the safety of small amusement rides which are currently under the jurisdiction of the Clark County Department of Development Services.

The proposed small ride exemption was drafted primarily to reduce the regulatory and financial burden imposed on small amusement rides, which provide a lower risk of rider injury compared to larger or faster rides.
