Field Application:

Clark County Department of Building & Fire Prevention Inspectors shall review the site “Storm Water Best Management Practices” (BMP) during rough grading, foundation, and framing inspections as required by CCDB&FP Policy and Procedure. The Inspector will identify and document any visible storm water violation observed during our rough grading, foundation, and framing inspections. The following inspection checklist shall serve as the determination of a potential storm water management hazard:

- a. Is there evidence of pollutant discharge from the property?
- b. Are roadways, storm drains, watercourse or swales or channels leading off site free of sedimentation, liter, waters and hazardous materials?
- c. Are material and equipment storage and maintenance areas reasonably clean and free of spills, leaks, or other sources of potentially polluting materials?
- d. Are material and waste managed adequately to minimize potential to impact the environment?
- e. Are the necessary BMP’s installed, functioning properly, and adequately maintained?
