Interpretation:

The Uniform Plumbing Code does not specifically reference these types of water heater installations. Section 501.0 does however state that "All design, construction, and workmanship shall be in conformity with accepted engineering practices, manufacturer's installation instructions and shall be of such character as to secure the results sought to be obtained by this code".

Field Application:

Non-Storage (instantaneous) hot water heaters **shall** be permitted to be installed provided the installation is in compliance with the manufacturer's listed instructions. Non storage (instantaneous) water heaters which supply water to more than one fixture shall be installed with a full way control valve placed immediately ahead of the unit. The venting portions of the unit shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's listed instructions.
