

Designated Residential Inspection Program – Mandatory Training

Pursuant to Request for Proposal RFP No. 6362-05, all Designated Residential Inspectors (DRIs), including designated Engineering Managers and Quality Managers, are required to complete a training course by Clark County.

The Building Division will be holding a training course on **Tuesday, May 23, 2006, in Presentation Rooms A,B and C** (4701 W. Russell Rd., Las Vegas, NV) from 7-12 noon. The training is divided into four modules:

1. Forms, general inspection sequence, clearances, meter tags
2. IRC, amendments, common building inspection concerns
3. UPC/UMC, amendments, common building inspection concerns
4. NEC, amendments, common building inspection concerns

In order to attend this training, you MUST:
