NOTICE TO POOL INDUSTRY

Pursuant to State regulations adopted at the 2005 legislative session regarding classifications of licenses and the establishment of qualifications, training, and examinations, Clark County will require contractors' employees making connections to a residential potable water supply for swimming pools and water features and the installation of gas piping to the pool heating equipment to receive training, obtain a Residential Pool Plumbing Specialist Certification card, and carry the card on their person. The certification card will be issued by the Southern Nevada Board of Plumbing Examiners. The effective date of compliance will be May 01, 2007.

The test was compiled from current editions of the Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC), the Southern Nevada Swimming and Spa Code, and USA North's Nevada Excavation Manual (call before you dig). The next three test dates are February 10th, March 10th and April 14th, 2007. Commencing May 12th, the exam will be provided on the 2nd Saturday of every other month. The test will consist of a 50-question open-book examination. A complete application must be submitted one month prior to the test date, along with the fee of \$75.00. Upon successful completion of the examination, the card/photo ID will be issued.
