## STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD

February 17, 2012

To Whom It May Concern:

Certain questions have arisen concerning work that may fall within the statutory exemption for maintenance and repair work contained in NRS 624.031(5).

In order to fall within the exemption, the value of the work, including labor of materials must not exceed \$1,000.

In addition to the monetary restriction, in order to qualify for an exemption:

- The work cannot require a building permit
- The work cannot involve plumbing, electrical, refrigeration, heating or air-conditioning
- The work cannot be part of a larger project the value of which is \$500 or more
- The work cannot be the type of work that significantly affects the health, safety and welfare of the public

**The exemption is not applicable to someone who holds a contractors license, or by an employee of the licensee.**

If there is any doubt concerning whether a contractors license is required, please submit written inquiries to either office of the Board.
