- **5% Inspection of Fabricated Items – Mark Hayes**
 - Perform a random inspection of a minimum of 5% of the shop welds and components for all approved fabricators, as required in IBC 1704.2.2.
- **TG-17-2011 – Brian Lenihan**
 - QMs should review the BAC and TG-17 to determine if an inspector requires an interview, determine the correct listing fee, including an interview fee if applicable.
 - Per the BAC 22.02.385 (2) (c) - The fee for conducting an interview for initial approval of an inspection category for special inspection personnel shall be One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$180.00).
- **Technician Interviews – Brian Lenihan**
 - EM's and QM's will now participate in the interview process.
 - Please provide permit numbers for projects that would be appropriate for the plan reading component.
 - Please provide ethics questions.
- **Annual Renewal – Brian Lenihan**
 - Revised QSM's that comply with TG-15 are required.
 - Agencies are required to include the special inspector audit summary, the project audit summary, and the completed internal office audit.
 - Agencies that have NDT personnel must comply with TG-16 Section 7.3.5.1. ASNT Level III inspector must audit the Level II inspector at least once per year.
- **TG-50 Update – Final and Daily Report Requirements – Brian Lenihan**
 - CCDDS-BD will have an industry group meeting to discuss modifications to the document.
 - Paperless submission of Reports.
- **Work Plans – Brian Lenihan**
 - Approved work plan has been executed without any modification. Submit all information in Final Report to Stewart Gillman
 - Approved work plan needed to be modified based on the inspections performed. Revised work must be approved to by engineer and plans examination. Submit all information in Final Report to Stewart Gillman. Do not submit revised work plan without Clark County approval in the Final Report.
- **Enforcement Issues – Brian Lenihan**
 - Unapproved inspectors
 - Grading reports are not clearly delineating Continuous and Periodic inspections
 - Pad Re-Certifications are more than top testing. A Pad Re-Certification must certify that all the fill that has been placed, even by a previous company, complies with the geotechnical report.
