INSPECTION RECORD RESIDENTIAL POOL / SPA

Permits become null and void if construction is not commenced within 180 days from date of issuance or work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days anytime after work is commenced.

CODE	REQUIRED INSPECTIONS	DATE-INSPECTOR	COMMENTS
6613	First Pool Excavation and steel complete with bonding, to include 4 bonding jumpers equally spaced attached to a #8 bonding ring encircling the pool, piping, electrical conduit and light shells installed and stubbed out. Pressure test on piping. Location on property and proximity to other structures verified.		
DO NOT GUNITE UNTIL ABOVE INSPECTION IS APPROVED			
3311	Underground Electrical (Contractor)		
6611	Underground Electrical (Owner/Builder) All underground conduit installed but not covered.		
6612	Underground Plumbing All underground piping installed, including gas piping. Piping may be shaded provided all connections remain exposed.		
3331	Rough Electrical (Contractor)		
6631	Rough Electrical (Owner/Builder) Electrical installation complete. Conduit covered. All conductors installed and terminated. All dead fronts labeled.		
6671	Pre-Plaster To be performed when all underground and rough inspections are approved; bonding is complete, plumbing is complete and the final plumbing inspection is approved. All electrical equipment shall be installed and conductors terminated. Dead fronts are to be labeled and access barriers complete. All safety requirements, alarms and/or secondary barriers, are complete and operational. Exception: Water hazard entrance alarms to be installed and inspected at pool final.		
DO NOT FILL POOL WITH WATER UNTIL ALL ABOVE INSPECTIONS ARE APPROVED			
3399	Final - Electrical (Contractor)		
6695	Final - Electrical (Owner/Builder) GFCI operational and accessible.		
6684	Gas Test and Tag		
6699	Final - Pool Pool Final: Pool and site drainage complete. Water hazard entrance alarms – if used as alarming method.		

**USE OF POOL IS NOT AUTHORIZED UNTIL ALL ABOVE INSPECTIONS ARE COMPLETE
A RE-INSPECTION FEE WILL BE ASSESSED AFTER A SECOND CONSECUTIVE FAILED INSPECTION**
