SUMMARY - An ordinance to amend Title 6, Chapter 6.12 of the Clark County Code to provide an "Aviation Support Provider" license category consistent with the definition in Title 20 (Airports); to repeal an obsolete aviation related license category; and to provide for other matters properly relating thereto.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 6, CHAPTER 6.12, SECTION 6.12.060 OF THE CLARK COUNTY CODE, TO REPLACE THE TERM "AIRLINE SERVICING COMPANY" WITH THE TERM "AVIATION SUPPORT PROVIDER" AND TO PROVIDE A REVISED DEFINITION FOR THAT TERM THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE NEWLY ADOPTED DEFINITION IN TITLE 20 (AIRPORTS); TO REPEAL SECTION 6.12.065 DUE TO OBSOLESCENCE OF THE LICENSE CATEGORY; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

SECTION 1. Title 6, Chapter 6.12, Section 6.12.060 is hereby amended as follows:

6.12.060 Aviation support provider~~[Airline servicing company]~~. Any person providing services such as, but not limited to, airline/aircraft services, ground handling services, ramp services, passenger services, ticketing services, baggage handling/baggage delivery services, ~~[-or]~~ aircraft cleaning services, maintenance services, fueling services, screening/security services, or catering/provisioning services to air transportation companies or air carriers, but excluding travel/tourist services, shall pay a semiannual

license fee determined by the amount of semiannual gross revenue as contained in the schedule of Section 6.12.995 of this chapter.

SECTION 2. Title 6, Chapter 6.12, Section 6.12.065, is hereby repealed as follows:

~~[6.12.065 Airline Ticket Locations. Any air transportation company or air carrier operating a remote location for the sale of air tickets or boarding passes shall pay a license fee of two hundred dollars annually for each location.]~~

SECTION 3. If any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. It is the intent of the county commission in adopting this ordinance that no portion or provision thereof shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any invalidity or unconstitutionality of any other portion or provision, and to this end all provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, clauses, phrases, or sentences contained in the Clark County Code in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the publication thereof by title only, together with the names of the County Commissioners voting for or against its passage, in a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in Clark County, Nevada, at least once a week for a period of two (2) weeks.
