

GAMING FEES – General County Licensing Fees – Resort Hotels

For gaming licenses containing the suffix “**GAM - 101**”

Gaming fees are payable in advance for each calendar quarter based on the number of games, tables, slots, or devices as follows:

Type of Game	Quarterly License Fee
Card Games (Poker, Panguini, other.)	\$75 per table
Counter or Table Game or Device other than slot machine (includes: craps, roulette, twenty-one, wheel of fortune, baccarat, Caribbean stud, let it ride, pai gow, keno, bingo, race book, sports book, other).	\$150 each
Individual Slot Machines	\$30 each **
Interactive Gaming	\$300 flat fee

** When a combination of units is operated by a single handle, with each unit paying identical denominations, fees are due for each individual unit that is part of the combination.
