

LIQUOR LICENSES – RENEWAL DUE DATE/DELINQUENT RENEWALS

Due Date

Liquor license fees must be paid (postmarked if sent via mail) on the last day of the current licensing period. However, payments are considered timely if they are received within 15 days after the due date.

Delinquent Renewals

Licenses fees that have not been paid (postmarked if sent via mail) within 15 days after the due date shall be considered delinquent and be subject to late payment penalties as set forth in the following section.

Late Payment Penalties

A 10% penalty will be charged if the license fee is paid 16-30 days after the due date.

A 10% penalty plus (and) a 15% penalty will be charged if the license fee is paid 31-60 days after the due date.

After 60 days double liquor fees shall be due.
