NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CLARK COUNTY CODE, CHAPTER 12.43

Dear Licensees and Community Partners:

Please be notified pursuant to NRS 237.080, that the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department has proposed amendments to Clark County Code, Title 12, Chapter 12.43, to prohibit pedestrian use of glass beverage containers within restricted areas on Las Vegas Boulevard South and certain adjoining areas at any time. The amendments are available for your review online at www.clarkcountynv.gov/depts/business_license.

Specifically, the proposed amendments will prohibit any pedestrian to be in possession of any glass beverage container which is not stapled closed in a plastic or paper bag with the sales receipt attached to the outside of the bag:

- (1) That portion of Las Vegas Boulevard from Russell Road to Sahara Avenue;
- (2) That portion of Mandalay Bay Road from Luxor Drive to Las Vegas Boulevard;
- (3) That portion of Tropicana Avenue from Koval Lane to two hundred feet west of its intersection with Las Vegas Boulevard;
- (4) That portion of Harmon Avenue from Interstate Highway 15 to Audrie Street;
- (5) That portion of Flamingo Road from Koval Lane to two hundred feet west of its intersection with Las Vegas Boulevard;
- (6) That portion of Spring Mountain/Sands Avenue, from the Fashion Show Drive to Koval Lane;
- (7) Each remaining street or highway not listed above that intersects Las Vegas Boulevard between Russell Road and Sahara Avenue for a distance of two hundred feet west and two hundred feet east of its intersection with Las Vegas Boulevard;
- (8) That portion of Paradise Road from Harmon Avenue to Karen Avenue;
- (9) Each highway that intersects Paradise Road from Harmon Avenue to Karen Avenue for a distance of two hundred feet east and two hundred feet west of its intersection with Paradise Road; and
- (10) That portion of Convention Center Drive from Las Vegas Boulevard to Paradise Road.

In accordance with NRS 237.080, business owners and interested parties may submit data and arguments to the Clark County Board of Commissioners, in care of the Department of Business License as to whether the proposed amendments will:

1. Impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a business; or
2. Directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of business
