NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CLARK COUNTY CODE, TITLE 12, CHAPTER 12.43

Dear Licensees and Community Partners:

Please be notified pursuant to NRS 237.080, of proposed amendments to Clark County Code, Title 12, Chapter 12.43, to prohibit the possession of opaque bags, strollers, and related items on the Las Vegas Strip on New Years' Eve, on the Fourth of July, and during certain special events; and providing for other matters properly relating thereto. The amendments are available for your review online at www.clarkcountynv.gov/depts/business_license.

Specifically, the proposed amendments will prohibit the following items on the Las Vegas Strip on New Years' Eve, on the Fourth of July, and during certain special events:

- (1) Aluminum beverage containers.
- (2) Purses larger than 8 inches by 6 inches by 2 inches.
- (3) Coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size of a purse, as set forth above.
- (4) Strollers, carts, or any vehicle propelled by humans, electricity, or mechanical means, unless a permit specifically authorizes the use of such item.

EXCEPTIONS: Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12". A logo may be imprinted on the bag provided that the logo does not obstruct external view of the contents of the bag. Medical devices and vehicles necessary for the immediate assistance of the patient utilizing such device.

In accordance with NRS.237.080, business owners and interested parties may submit data and arguments to the Clark County Board of Commissioners, in care of the Department of Business License as to whether the proposed amendments will:

1. Impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a business; or
2. Directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of business
