The undersigned understands that the liquor license of the seller must remain active and in good standing, and all of the seller's quarterly liquor license fees must continue to be paid during all periods that the undersigned is operating on a temporary liquor license. The undersigned further understands that if the seller's liquor license fees become delinquent, the temporary liquor license may be revoked.
