I am writing this letter in order to support the "Nellis Dunes Recreation Project". Please convey the land so that it can be used for the Off-road community. As an avid off-road and motocross enthusiast, I see the need for such a project, especially with the growing population of Clark County.

Currently, I am one of the Owner/Operators of Sandy Valley Motocross. We built the facility in order to service the Las Vegas motocross riders that have no where to ride. We are letting you know that there is a high demand for riding areas. Safe and controlled environments to actively pursue off-road recreation need to be provided by the County. Areas open to all types of off road activities. The population is out there, they currently keep our business open and available for public use.

Support of the facility in the long run, has nothing but positive effects on the Las Vegas Community as a whole and as off-road enthusiasts. Providing an area will:

1. Keep all off-road activities in a monitored area (out of illegal riding areas).
2. Provides safe design and maintenance of trail & track systems.
3. Provides a Cash-Flow into the project and local economy from the people/groups using it.
4. Creates another good reason, besides gaming, to live in and visit Las Vegas.
5. Keeps Air Quality at acceptable levels. Wet, groomed and well maintained tracks often do not create dust pollution. As many as 100 riders can ride a wet track and make less dust than 1 bike in the dry desert (same goes for Trucks, buggies and ATVs).
6. Provides medical help in the event of an accident.
7. Preserves our Native Desert Environments, tortoise habitat and desert wildlife from the harmful effects of off road use in illegal areas.
8. Provides an easily accessible area in Las Vegas for Organized National Off-road Events.
9. Gives families and tourists in the Las Vegas Regional area a great location to enjoy off-road motorsports.
10. Makes great use of an otherwise barren area, subject to dumping and misuse. The facilities could be impeccably designed & maintained to the standard of the Las Vegas Lifestyle.

The list could continue. Off-Road enthusiasts are abundant in Clark County. I can imagine many Organizations working together to make Las Vegas a premiere stop in the Off-Road World. We need your support to continue this project and make it a reality.
