**Notes & Highlights**

The Sign-in to see a worker (number) displays all occurrences for the month in question.

The Medical Assistance (total clients) displays all clients with eligibility for the month in question. The number of people with eligibility may not have had their eligibility determined in the month in question. For example, a client with six months of eligibility displayed in February 2012 may have had their eligibility determined in December 2011. Since they have eligibility for six months, the client will register as "receiving service" till the completion of May 2012. This being the case, the client will be displayed as receiving services for February, and subsequent months till the completion of their eligibility of service (May 2012). The Medical Assistance (total clients) number will often be larger than the Sign-in to see a worker number, this is expected behavior.

The Clark County Unemployment Rate is determined and finalized approximately two months after the period. For example, January rate will be available in March.
