<sup>1</sup>Response time measures from call pickup to first arriving unit on scene to all emergency incidents. CCFD response time goal is 7 minutes to 90% percent of the incidents.

<sup>2</sup>Other category includes responses and incidents such as smoke investigations, extrications, fuel spills, etc.

<sup>3</sup>Responded to vehicle fires in California and outlying areas.

<sup>4</sup>Peak units are deployed during expected high-call volume days and times on an 8 hour shift. These units were implemented on January 13, 2012.

<sup>5</sup>Civilian Fire Casualties will be updated at the end of the year due to the amount of time to investigate.
