



ELECTION DAY SCHEDULE

November 2, 2010 General Election



***Except for the opening and closing of the polls,
the times below are estimates.***

- 7:00 a.m. Polls open.
- 11:30 a.m. Turnout figures will be available.
- 4:00 p.m. Updated turnout figures will be available.
- 7:00 p.m. Close of polling places. Any voters waiting in line to vote will be brought inside the polling place and allowed to vote.
- 7:30–8:00 p.m. *(when voting is complete at the polls)* After 7:00 p.m., once any lines at the polling places have dissipated, the tabulation process begins at the [Election Center](#). Tabulated results for early voting ballots and for mail/absentee ballots received before Election Day will be available on [TV Channel 4](#) and on the [Internet](#).
- 8:00-10:30 p.m. Results cartridges from polling places are delivered to the [Election Center](#). They are read by a cartridge reader into the County's election tabulation system. Results are uploaded to the Internet about every 20 to 30 minutes throughout the evening. Hard copies are also printed for [distribution](#) about every 20 to 30 minutes. Mail/absentee ballots received on Election Day are tabulated after the Election Day cartridges are read. The results reported on election night will not include provisional ballots.
