



# EARLY VOTING PROCESS

## September 13, 2011 Special Election for Congressional District 2



Overview: The 14-day early voting period for the September 13, 2011 Special Election for Congressional District 2 begins August 27 (Saturday) and ends September 9 (Friday). Only voters registered in Congressional District 2 may vote before Election Day at any one of the 6 early voting sites. Early voting hours and dates of operation vary by location. [Early voting schedules](#) are in sample ballots, newspapers and on the [Internet](#).

Voting Machines: All polling places are equipped with [electronic touch-screen voting machines](#). These machines include a voter verifiable paper printout of each ballot. The printout stays with the machine. The machines also provide [Spanish](#) and English ballots and instructions.

Special Election Voting: Only persons registered to vote at an address in Congressional District 2 may vote. They may vote for any candidate on the ballot, regardless of political party affiliation.

No Write-Ins: [Nevada Revised Statute \(NRS\) 293.270](#) prohibits write-in candidates.

### Early Voting Process:

- Upon arriving at the site, your voting eligibility and signature will be verified before you are allowed to vote. The election Clerk will announce your name, as required by Nevada law ([NRS 293.285](#)).
  - *NOTE: It is always a good idea to bring picture identification with you when you vote.*
- Computers at each site connect to the Election Department's centralized voter files. After the verification process, the Clerk will immediately update your record, thus preventing anyone from voting twice.
- You will then receive an activation card to take to a voting machine.
- Insert the activation card into a voting machine to activate it for your specific precinct. You may now [vote](#).
- When you finish voting, immediately return the activation card to an election official.

Early Voting Turnout: Daily early voting turnout (total voters per site) will be updated on the [Internet](#) each night around 8:00 p.m.

Results Tabulation: Tabulated results are not available until after 7:00 p.m. on Election Day and are on the [TV Channel 4](#) or the [Internet](#).
