NOTICE TO ELECTORS OF CLOSE OF REGISTRATION FOR PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 12, 2012

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Registrar of Voters of Clark County, Nevada, will conduct a registration of qualified electors for the Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, June 12, 2012.

Any qualified elector whose name does not appear on the official registry list may apply for registration by appearing before the Registrar of Voters or before a Deputy Registrar in the manner approved by law. A qualified elector who possesses a Nevada driver's license or DMV-issued Identification Card may register or update his/her voter registration information online at www.clarkcountynv.gov/vote.

Voter registration applications and registration information updates will be accepted that are completed or mailed up until 31 days before the election. Thereafter until 21 days before the election, voter registration applications and registration information updates must be filed in person at either office of the Clark County Registrar of Voters.



Nevada law requires first-time registrants who registered to vote prior to January 1, 2006 and did not provide identification at the time they registered to provide identification when they vote in person for the first time or request a mail ballot. Forms of current and valid identification include a Nevada Driver's License, Nevada I.D. Card, military identification card OR a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or document issued by a government entity, listing the registrant's name and residential address.

Nevada and federal law require first-time registrants who registered after December 31, 2005 and provided an identifying number (Nevada driver's license number or the last four digits of their social security number) that did not match the records maintained by the Department of Motor Vehicles or Social Security Administration to present identification. Forms of current and valid identification include a Nevada Driver's License, Nevada I.D. Card, military identification card OR a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or document issued by a government entity, listing the registrant's name and residential address. These individuals have been notified by mail of this requirement.

Registration for electors for the 2012 Primary Election will be closed after 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 22, 2012.
